Terms of Service DicDoc.ai

1. General; Acceptance of Terms

Welcome to DicDoc.ai ("Service"), whis is a visual STD (STI) analytics engine using artificial intelligence (AI).

2. Definitions

2.1. In the Terms, "User," "you" and "your" refer to the individual or entity that uses the Service (End user). "DicDoc.ai," "we," "us" and "our" refer to DicDoc.ai. "End user" refers to the person who uploads an image to the Service.

3. The Service in summary

- 3.1. DicDoc.ai is a website that lets the user use a dermatology analytics engine (search engine) powered by AUTODERM an AI on 68 different skin disease classes. Which include the majority of genital skin concerns the average person can have.
- 3.2. AUTODERM analytics engine is not a DIAGNOSTIC TOOL and does not give a final DIAGNOSIS. It is for informational and educational purposes to allow the End user to upload images of skin conditions, seeking information and guidance. Just like a search engine, but instead of submitting text and looking at the images results. One submits an image and gets text back, for further information.
- 3.3. The Service permits users to upload images of skin conditions privately to receive 5 answers ranked in order of possibility, and can be read on an interface.
- 3.4. End user is anonymous and the uploaded images are NOT collected or stored. The image is only used to make the analysis.
- 3.5. By using the Service in any way, you are agreeing to comply with and be bound by this Agreement and the Privacy Policy, as applicable (collectively "Related Agreements"), and all rules, policies and disclaimers posted on the Service or about which you are notified (collectively "Terms"). - 4.1. Patient population (gender, age, ethnicity, layman)
 - 4.1.1. Any gender.
 - 4.1.2. Any age.
 - 4.1.3. Any ethnicity.
 - 4.1.4. Any language.
 - 4.1.5. Layman.
 - 4.1.6. Healthcare workers.

4.2. Indications - End user

- 4.2.1. Healthcare worker: Clinical decision support tool on skin diseases that provides clinicians and staff to enhance decision-making in the clinical workflow.
- 4.2.2. The layman (patient): A skin analytics tool on skin diseases to be used as a search engine on skin disease to help find the right information for the possible skin disease.

4.3. Intended user

4.3.1. Any person that wants guidance on a visual skin concern.

4.4. How to use it

4.4.1. For the best output: take a focused picture with any smartphone of any visual skin lesion anywhere on the body that the analytics engine has

been trained for, in good lighting and no interference of the area that will be analyzed. The user should refrain from drawing on the picture, have markings, or any objects in the picture. A clear monomized background is also preferred.

4.5. Precautions of use

- 4.5.1. To get a good answer any skin disease that the analytics engien has been trained on should be used.
- 4.5.2. One skin disease should be in the image.
- 4.5.3. Try and include an image that best describes the disease. There are no specification distance measures. But should represent how a doctor would look at a skin lesion in order to make a sound judgment.
- 4.5.4. No skin contact.

4.6. Benefit claims

4.6.1. Help find a skin disease instantly, which increases the quality of care and enhances health outcomes. Improved efficiency, cost-benefit, and provider and patient satisfaction.

4.7. Non-clinical benefits

- 4.7.1. For many of the skin diseases the End user can be guided to self-treatment with prescription free over the counter (OTC) medication.
- 4.7.2. Many skin diseases the End user can be guided to online laboratory tests.

4.8. Disclaimer

- 4.8.1. Healthcare worker: The results should be used as a decision support tool on skin diseases. The healthcare worker makes the final judgement on diagnosis and follows up the patient with care, which can include communication and a treatment plan. The analytics engine is not a self diagnostic tool.
- 4.8.2. Layman (patient): The results should be interpreted as how they treat results when using an internet search engine or an online symptom checker. It is not a final verified diagnosis.

4.9. Risks and side effect

4.9.1. There are no considerable risks if used as described above. However with any skin condition, if it does not improve or worsens in time, then the healthcare worker should either see the patient again, or the layman should seek a doctor in person.
